
ANDREAXCAMPOS.COM ODREASDOODLES




I LOVE quirky characters, clever humor, and stories with twists and turns. A mystery where readers need to sleuth through pictures for clues would be a dream to illustrate!





Themes of nature, friendship, imagination, and magic woven into stories of loss and triumph, humor and transformation are in every book I have made and every book I hope to make.



















I AM MOST DRAWN to stories that are whimsical and sweet with a touch of silly. As a mushroom forager, I love any stories about the underbellies of the forest.
















